ECI offers internships at its community headquarters in Washington, D.C. The internship program is designed to provide a Therapeutic Understanding in the Helping Profession as Counselors with an opportunity to learn and to develop competencies and to demonstrate relationship skills that are ethical.

Internship Positions Available: Internship/volunteer opportunities are available in most areas of the counseling profession. Lists of the specific openings are listed on our application forms that can be download from our website. www.theecumenicalcounselinginstitute.com

Eligibility: A candidate must be a graduate student; an undergraduate student; or have graduated and seek to advance your career towards certification. Others may be referred by the court system or high school to perform community work.

We are looking for: Strong Interpersonal Skills, Effective Communication Skills, Strong Research Skills, Strong Writing Skills

General Information: Interns are expected to work a minimum of 20 to 40 hours.

All other times will be subject to a one/one interview and course requirement for graduation, state licensure/certification board, or academic supervisor. If required, interns may receive academic credit if an agreement is made between ECI Human Resources Department and the intern's college or university.

Application Procedures: Candidates must complete and application form and submit it with their cover letter and resume. Some internship positions may require additional application items, such as a written sample or background check. All application items must be submitted as a complete package. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Application Deadlines: For the Summer program, applications are due by February 14; the Fall program, applications are due by the July 4; and for the Winter/Spring program, applications are due by November 11th
